Position Available: Recreation Program Leader III

Summary:

Under the direct supervision of the program Supervisor, the Recreation Program Leader III is responsible for assistance in carrying out both indoor and outdoor activities, working directly with participants to encourage enthusiasm in recreation activities and carrying out activities related to the physical well being and comfort of the participants in program.

Essential Job Functions:

- Implement individual behavior plans.
- Plan, lead and evaluate various activities in accordance to participant's individual program plan. (Activities include a wide variety of critical skills training, pre-vocational training, and recreation and community integration.)
- Implement recreation programs and special events.
- Assist participants in recreational swimming programs.
- Ensure the safety of participants and that safety precautions are observed in all activities.
- Prepare programs, announcements, bulletins and related materials in program.
- Assist the participants in feeding, lifting and personal hygiene.
- Effectively communicate with co-workers and participants.
- Be able to lift 50 pounds.

Job Standards:

- Two years of college education in Therapeutic Recreation, Special Education, Psychology or related field.
- One-year experience working with special populations. (Experience working with adults with severe and profound mental retardation *preferred*)
- Equivalent experience may be substituted for up to two years of college education.
- Pre-employment physical, TB and FBI fingerprint clearance.
- First Aid and C.P.R. Certification within the first 30 days of employment.

Up to 35 hours per week (Monday through Friday), flexible within program hours. Full and part-time positions available.
