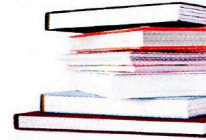
Our History

For over two decades, the St. Francis' Church Mouse Thrift Shop has been committed to selling quality second hand items to the community. With the initial volunteer staff being comprised of parishioners of St. Francis' Episcopal Church, the thrift shop opened its doors to the public in October 1984. Prior to that, sales were held on the corner of San Fernando and Ocean Avenue to raise money for the renovation of the present location.

In 2005, the St. Francis' Church Mouse Thrift Shop began their partnership with The Janet Pomeroy Center, expanding its days and hours, while continuing their mission in giving back to the community. Dedicated volunteers from the St. Francis' Episcopal Church and the community continue to volunteer alongside the staff and clients of The Janet Pomeroy Center to this day.

The Janet Pomeroy Center:

Who We Are

In 1952, Janet Pomeroy founded the Recreation Center for the Handicapped to provide programs and services to families with developmentally disabled children. Janet started with just two volunteers and six teens in one room in the old Fleishhacker Pool Building. In 2004, the Recreation Center for the Handicapped changed its name to The Janet Pomeroy Center, in honor of the incredible woman who founded the Center decades ago.

The Employment and Training Services department provides support and hands on training for clients with vocational goals. At the St. Francis' Church Mouse Thrift Shop, clients learn valuable skills in retail, stock, and customer service. Because of the rigorous training program, many clients have moved on to competitive employment in the community.
